Kindergarten Curriculum

We are excited to present a biblical worldview to our students, even as young as K5. By using both A Beka and Bob Jones University Press curriculum, GCS is able to teach the students about Creation, the Fall, Redemption, and Restoration and how it relates to their lives as children. Our goal is to point them to the saving knowledge of Christ along with helping them cultivate a relationship with Jesus. The curriculum includes this philosophy not only in Bible class, but across all subjects throughout the day.

Bible: The students will be introduced to God's plan for their lives and be guided in learning truths from the Bible, beginning with Creation, the life of Christ, and the life of Paul.

Phonics: The students will cultivate a love of reading. They will learn basic letter sounds as well as syllable patterns with an emphasis on word families. A solid foundation of phonemic awareness and phonics instruction is built through the curriculum.

Reading: The students will cultivate a love of reading. There are colorful illustrations, age-appropriate texts, and wonderful selections that will spark the student's interest. There are reading groups daily where the focus will be on fluency, speed, and comprehension.

Spelling: The students will have words chosen as part of the reading curriculum.

Handwriting: The students will learn how to write using the Handwriting Without Tears Kindergarten program. It incorporates a hands-on learning approach along with multi-sensory activities that teach good early handwriting habits. Using music and movement, it really makes learning fun.

Math: The students will learn basic math skills using an interactive approach, which builds a strong foundation of number sense. BJU Press and A Beka offers many manipulatives to make learning a hand-on experience. Concepts introduced are addition, subtraction, measurement, time, calendar, and early geometry.

Heritage Studies/Science: History and Science is integrated throughout our Kindergarten curriculum. Students learn about God's plan for His creation. They learn about geography, United States history, the human body, animals, plants, and much more. There are themed units throughout the curriculum for special holidays and events as well.

Centers: Centers are an active part of a Kindergarten's life. Students are in a daily rotation to take part in different center activities such as housekeeping, language arts, computers, science, reading, and puzzle/games. During reading group time, several students will be reading, several will be at their desks doing seatwork, and several students will be in the center room with the center teacher.

Special Classes: Kindergarten students have opportunities to become well-rounded as they take part in many activities such as art, music, choir, PE, library, computer, Spanish, and Chapel every Thursday.

Field Trips: There will be 2-3 field trips throughout the school year. Each trip will enhance what students are learning in the classroom.

Class Parties: We celebrate holidays with parties for Thanksgiving, Christmas, Valentine's Day, and Easter. There are also small celebrations for fall and St. Patrick's Day. Birthdays will also be celebrated throughout the year.
